Augustine Owusu-Asiedu of Waukesha, died unexpectedly on Monday, April 11, 2022 at the age of 53. Originally from Ghana, West Africa, Augustine immigrated to Canada in 1996. A career in Animal Science led him to relocate to England in 2008, and then to the United States in 2009. His passions included politics, travel, and sports. He was his kid's biggest fan, and could be seen at all their sporting events and activities.

He will be sadly and forever missed by his family; Lisa, Avery and Aidan; his parents, Henry Isaac and Comfort Boateng of Ghana; his siblings, Kenneth, Grace, Agnes and Joyce; many nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Albert, William and Harry.
